Dear athletes,  
Dear friends of rowing,

A warm welcome to Brandenburg an der Havel for the 2026 European Rowing Under 19 Championships. On May 23 and 24, 2026, around 800 young athletes from many European countries will gather at the Beetzsee regatta course. For two days, the focus will be on exciting races and international competition.

The championship also marks the highlight of this year's rowing season in Brandenburg an der Havel. The German team will be represented by a large delegation. For some Brandenburg athletes, this also presents an opportunity to compete as part of the U19 national team and race in front of their home crowd.

The final races on Sunday promise some special sporting moments. I am delighted to have the opportunity to personally present some of the awards.

The Beetzsee regatta course is one of the venues in international rowing richest in tradition. National and international championships have been held here for decades. Generations of athletes have competed here for titles, records, and personal bests.

Rowing demands the utmost precision, endurance, and teamwork. Every movement must be perfect; the boat only functions when everyone is in sync. British Olympic champion and rowing author Sir Steven Geoffrey Redgrave aptly summed up the essence of this sport: "Rowing is the ultimate team sport—success comes only when everyone does the same thing at the exact same time."

For many of the young participants, this European Championship serves as an important benchmark on their path to the top of international sport. Some of them may go on to compete in World Championships or the Olympic Games in a few years' time.

Brandenburg an der Havel has close ties to rowing. The Ruder-Club-Havel Brandenburg, founded in 1906 and of which I am a member, has produced numerous talented athletes. A recent example is Sarah Wibberenz. She won gold in the quadruple sculls at the 2019 European Junior Championships, took silver at the Junior World Championships that same year, and again at the 2021 U23 World Championships. In 2025, she followed that up with silver at the European Championships and bronze at the World Championships in the quadruple sculls.

The regatta course itself can also look back on significant development. It celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2019. Over the past few years, more than 5 million euros have been invested in its modernization. New starting facilities, state-of-the-art technology in the finish tower, a large video wall, accessible boat ramps, and a partially covered grandstand create ideal conditions for national and international competitions. And further investments in the competition venue are already planned so that is sustainable for the long-term use.

A big thank you goes to the organizers, the Brandenburg State Rowing Association, the Havel Regatta Club, the international and national associations, and the many volunteers. Their dedication makes this championship possible.

I extend my best wishes to the athletes for fair and successful races. I wish everyone exciting competitions.

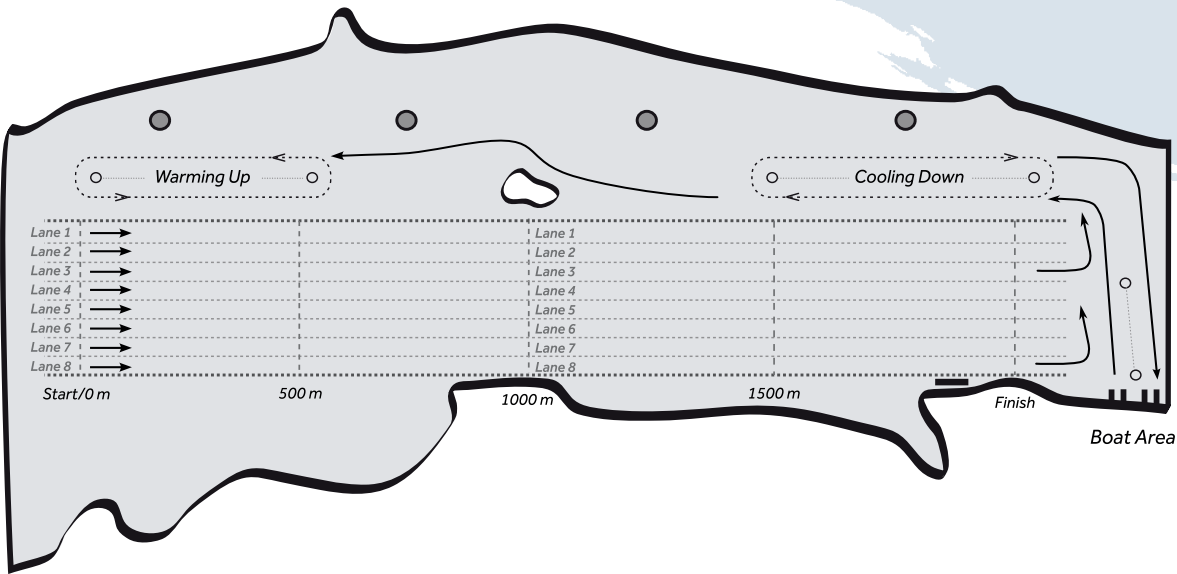

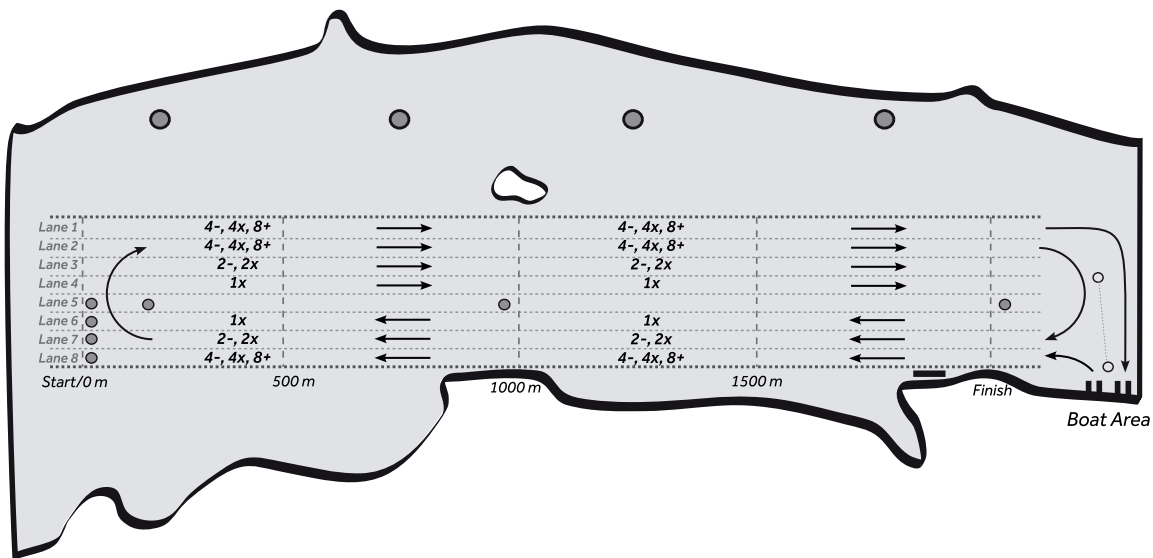

## OPENING CEREMONY

Date and Time: Friday, 18:30 hrs  
Location: In front of the grand stand.

The OC kindly asks each participating team to provide one athlete as representative for the flag processing ceremony to show up at 18:15 hrs, latest, at the bottom of the finish tower.

## TRAINING AND COMPETITION ON THE COURSE

### CONTROL COMMISSION

The Control Commission is located between the incoming and outgoing pontoons.

The Control Commission will be in operation during all times the course is officially open.

### CREW PHOTOS

Team Managers will be notified of the athletes who do not have their photographs. These athletes must have their passport style photograph with a light background uploaded to the World Rowing database by Thursday, 21 May, 17:00.

### BOW NUMBERS

The bow numbers will be distributed to the crews on the outgoing pontoon and collected on the incoming pontoon.

### ADVERTISING

Please check the World Rowing Rules of Racing and related Bye-Laws to ensure that your racing uniforms and boats comply with the advertising rules.

### BOAT WEIGHING

The boat weighing station is located at the end of the boat park area in a tent. No test scales will be available. The scales will be available from Thursday 21 May 2026 and will be operational during all the official opening hours of the course, except during racing sessions.

## TRAINING AND COMPETITION ON THE COURSE

### COX WEIGHING

Cox weighing will be done in the boat park building. Use the middle entrance and turn to the left. The room with the scales is on the right hand side. Test scales will be available from Thursday 21 May 2026, during opening hours of the venue and the space in front of the weighing area.

### TRAFFIC RULES (TRAINING)

The traffic rules for training will apply at all the times that the course is open for training.

### TRAFFIC RULES (RACING)

The traffic rules for racing will be applied 15 minutes before the start of the first race of the day until 15 min. after the start of the last race of each racing session. For the lunch break on Saturday, traffic rules for racing will be applied 30 minutes before the start of the afternoon session."

### PRACTICE STARTS

Crews will be able to do practice starts during training on Friday, 22 May 2026 from 15:00 hrs to 16:00 hrs. The traffic light system will be used for practice starts.

### SPARES RACES

Teams wishing to enter their spare athletes for spares races must submit a completed spares races form to the venue accreditation office in Brandenburg by 13:00 hrs on Friday, 22 May.

## TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

### BOAT STORAGE

The boat racks are situated in the boat park area. The Organising Committee will assign boat racks for all boats. Teams are responsible for their boats to be safely tied to the racks and are in no risk to be damaged due to adverse weather conditions.

### PONTOONS

There are two outgoing and two incoming pontoons.

### BOAT AND REPAIR SERVICES

Empacher and Filippi offer boat and repair service in the boat park area. The service providers are located at the fence, left of the entry to the boat park.

### BOAT WASHING

No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used during boat washing. The boat washing is located on the far end of the boat park building (in direction of the beach).

### ERGOMETERS

Ergometers for training and warming up or cooling down will be provided in the back of the boat park building, entrance from the middle entrance on the boat park side. Each athlete must disinfect the equipment before and after use.

### TEAM TENT AREA

It is not possible to rent a tent from the Organising Committee.

An Athletes Rest Area will also be available in tents in the boat park area. Those are free for all athletes to be used, but not supposed to be reserved by a single team.

## TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES

### SANITARY FACILITIES/RESTROOMS

The restrooms and showers for athletes can be found in the boat park building.

### BAG STORAGE

The bag drop-off will be open during the official opening hours of the course and is located in the boat park building nearby the ergometer area.

### REST AREAS

Team members can use the space nearby the ergometers, the changing rooms as well as the tents in the boat park area for resting.

### VIEWING AREA FOR ATHLETES

Athletes can watch the races from the main grandstand.

### COACHES VIEWING

It is not possible to follow the races along the course. Coaches and other team members can watch the races on the big screen opposite from the grandstand.

### BIKE RENTAL

No bike rental services will be provided by the 2026 ERU19CH OC.

## MEDICAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES

### RESCUE AND SAFETY

There will be an on-water rescue team in charge of on-water rescue during official hours of the regatta course. Two ambulances will be on duty during racing and one during training.

### DOPING CONTROL

The Doping Control Centre is located in the Medical Centre above the boathouse. All doping control tests will be conducted in accordance with WADA and World Rowing requirements. For all information about the Anti-Doping controls and procedures, please refer to the World Anti-Doping Code and International Standards available on the website [www.wada-ama.org](http://www.wada-ama.org) and the World Rowing Anti-Doping Bye-Laws. Further information is available on the World Rowing website [www.worldrowing.com](http://www.worldrowing.com). Please be reminded that in case of anti-doping controls, your athletes will be required to have a photo identification with them at the venue.

### EMERGENCY

## ACCREDITATION

### CREW CHANGES

Upon arrival, Team Managers are requested to check their crew entries at the Accreditation and Information Centre. In case of any changes in the crew's composition, seating order or spelling of the names, they must complete the Crew Change Form and submit it to the Organising Committee at the Accreditation and Information Centre no later than Friday, 22 May 2026, 13:00.

### COUNTRY CODE STICKERS

For safety reasons crews will be required to have their country code stickers on the boats before being allowed onto the water, both for training and racing. OC volunteers or NTOs will assist the crews to fix the stickers on the boats. Please ask the Team Information Centre or check the Team Managers Whatsapp group for information about where and when to collect the country code stickers. Please plan for sufficient time for the fixing of the stickers before the first training session. In addition to the country code stickers, European Rowing Stickers will be distributed and should be fixed to the boats.

### BLADES IDENTIFICATION

As described in the WR Rules, from the time the venue is officially open for training, the teams are required to ensure that all blades are painted in Member Federation colours before going on the water.
